



GOLDTOUR 27 Flatruet

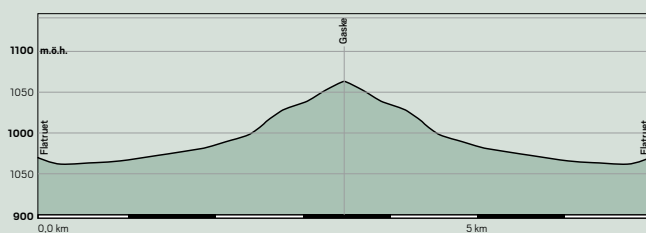
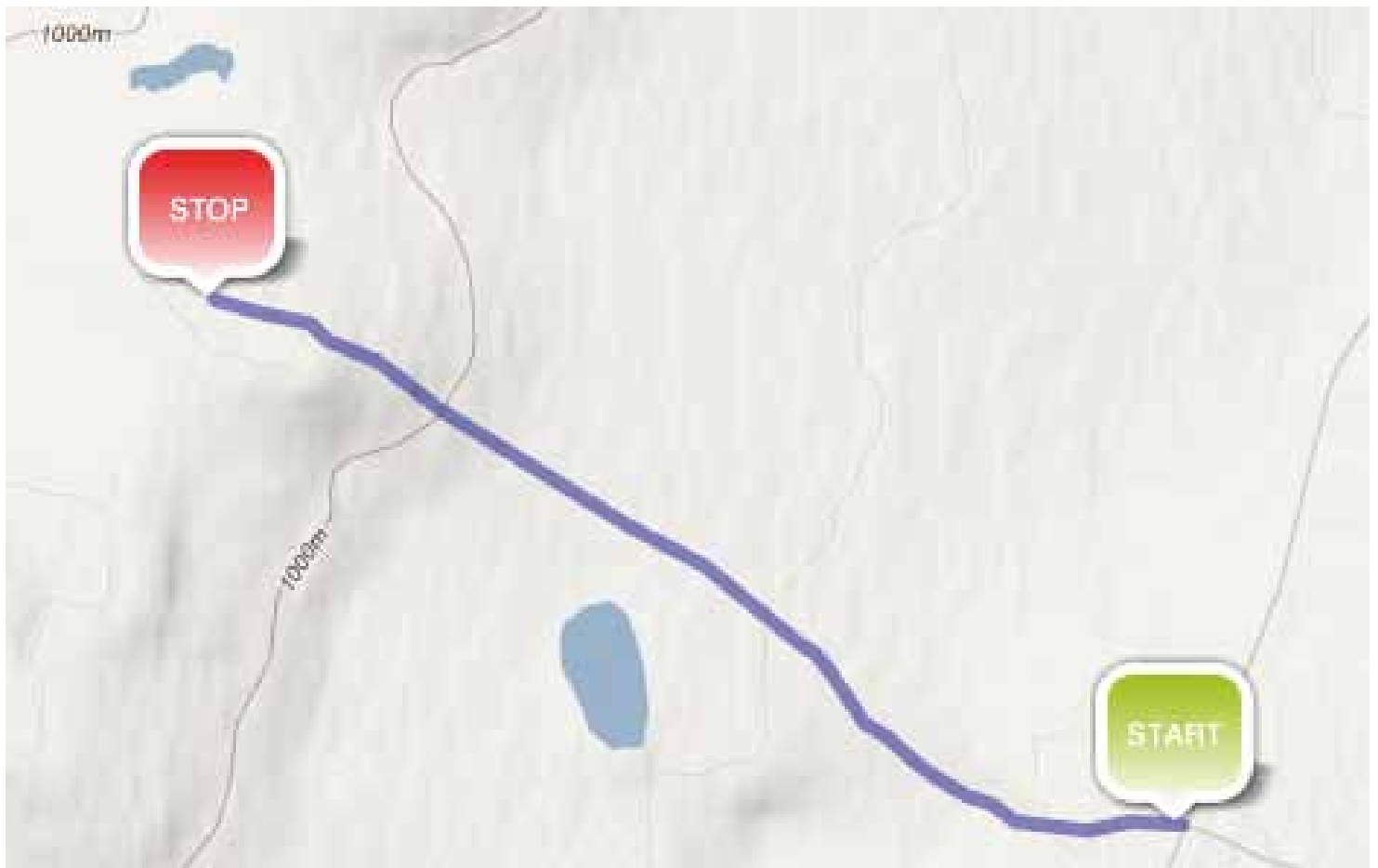
Easy walk with fantastic views.

START LOCATION

Road 531 between Mittådalen and Ljungdalen, park at the highest point at the information sign – Sveriges högst belägna landsväg! (Sweden's highest road!)

DESCRIPTION OF THE TRIP

This tour is suitable for those who want to try hiking for the first time, easy approval and appropriate length. Suitable for both children and the elderly.

From the highest point on Flatruet, 975 meters above sea level, go west, if you come from Funäsdalen it will be left. Follow a tractor road, there is no specific trail marking but it is easy to follow. The road eventually turns into a path that winds up on the mountain plateau and you see that it leads towards three soft-shaped peaks. Here is the residency of the European Golden Plover and the melancholy song can be heard in all directions. Here you can also see The Long-tailed Skua (*Stercorarius lobbicaudus*) hunting over the plateau.

After 2 km, trail starts to go easily up to the middle of the three peaks named Gaske-Miesjehkentjahke. On the top you are at 1066 meters altitude and has a stunning panorama in front of you. Straight ahead 25 km away, you see Skars mountains near the Norwegian border. Towards Skars you see a lot of large and small lakes framed by mountain peaks in different shapes and sizes. To the left you will see Mittåkläppen with its characteristic profile, 1212 meters high. To the right you will see Helags, 1796 meters, with Sweden's most southerly glaciers. Further to the right you will see the massive Dunsjöfjällen whose highest peak is 1415 meters above sea level. If you have Z8 Mountain Map with you, you will be able to identify more peaks.

Now it's time to find a suitable place and take a well earned coffee break and enjoy the magnificent scenery. On the way home, you will see no high mountain peaks, but a large part of plateau Flatruet. Various findings have shown that this isolated plateau was wooded with large trees for 8000 years ago and it was only 2000 years after the Ice Age ended.



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
