

Swedens most MTB-area



26. Ljusnedal - Lossen - Tännäs.



Green. 55 km.

Various bikeride on asphalt and gravel road. The trip takes about 3 hours.

Start out from hotel Gyllene Bocken in Ljusnedal and follow the gravel road north of Ljusnedalssjön (and eventually the lake Lossen). The gravel road starts at the golf course. Easy cycling with beautiful views. After a few km there is an excellent cold source on the left hand where you can quench your thirst. Along the gravel road is a detour to the left, for those who want some extra pitch and views.

As you approach the end of Lossen, turn right and bike up on top of the several hundred meter-long pondwall. On the other side you can reach highway 84 where you take off towards Tännäs. Now there are some uphill slopes waiting before you reach the top of Ramberget, but then you have some downhill slopes back to sealevel again. When you reach the lake Lossen you turn to the left towards Tännäs by the skiresort sign (Skidanläggning/Tännäskröket) and continue the gravel road until you reach the bigger road. Turn right and pass Tännån up to the church. In Tännäs village you can shop in the store Oscars liv or maybe get something to eat at Tännäsgården.

When you have passed the church you turn left at the crossroads. The asphalt road will eventually turn into a gravel road. The gravel road will take you over the "mountain" down to mainroad 84. After a few kilometers you will cross the bridge over Funån and then you will come to the crossroads in to Ljusnedal. Follow the road until you reach your starting point at Gyllene Bocken
